On successful completion of the General Education Award in English for Foreigners Level 1, the learner will be able to:

- ✓ Ensure proper use of vowels and consonants, in order to improve one's writing and reading skills
- ✓ Utilize effective sentence structure when speaking and writing
- ✓ Use the correct verbs and tenses, including the Present Simple, Present Continuous and negative verbs
- ✓ Ensure proper time-reading
- ✓ Comply with personal pronouns rules in both a grammatical and vocabular context
- ✓ Ensure the right names attributed to colours are used
- ✓ Compose basic sentences, read calendars and schedule appointments
- ✓ Make use of adjectives and opposites
- ✓ Conform to gender ruling nouns
- ✓ Select the correct day of the week, when addressing particular event/ routines that take place on a weekly basis

- ✓ Conform to the rules relating to the present perfect simple and continuous in a grammatical and vocabulary context
- ✓ Ensure that the correct modal verb is used when communicating in English
- ✓ Create sentences using the correct adverb
- ✓ Understand the characteristics pertaining to the passive voice
- ✓ Comply with the rules relating to relative clauses and question words, for effective communication
- ✓ Use the first and subjunctive conditional to alter the structure of a sentence
- ✓ Use zero articles and adjectival nouns to allow proper grammatical and vocabular structure
- ✓ Create an effective CV and a letter of application
