On successful completion of the Vocational Education and Training Award for Cleaning Attendants, the learner will be able to:

- ✓ Ensure a positive attitude towards work by keeping motivated throughout the daily cleaning tasks
- ✓ Collaborate with other cleaners and staff through effective communication
- ✓ Be responsible for asking assistance when faced with First Aid scenarios
- ✓ Carry out effective cleaning tasks by avoiding risk hazards, so as to ensure optimum safety
- ✓ Deal with mathematical calculations in an independent manner
- ✓ Apply the correct mathematical calculation according to the respective cleaning task at hand
- ✓ Manage daily mathematical applications with confidence and autonomy
- ✓ Comply with the conformities of the Colour Coding Cleaning System, Hand Hygiene procedure and the pH Indicator
- ✓ Identify the correct cleaning methodology
- ✓ Carry out effective cleaning tasks that require large equipment
- ✓ Use the correct cleaning tools according to the task at hand
- ✓ Dispense chemicals effectively, by paying particular attention to the environment
- ✓ Comply with relevant local waste control and environmental regulations
- ✓ Carry out specific cleaning tasks that are designed to meet the different cleaning industry requirements
- ✓ Apply the correct chemical mixing measurements when disinfecting/cleaning a designated area
- ✓ Adhere to the colour coding system, in order to avoid bacterial contamination
- ✓ Comply with the respective cleaning procedures assigned in accordance to the working environment
- ✓ Collaborate with management and peers in the implementation of appropriate waste management practices
