On successful completion of the Vocational Education and Training Award in Stone Masonry and Brick Laying, the learner will be able to:

- ✓ Conform to Health & Safety regulations for the building industry
- ✓ Comply with sanitary and building laws of Malta on a given building project
- ✓ Use suitable building trade terminology in a given context
- ✓ Perform building tasks using the appropriate building tools safely and correctly
- ✓ Carry out routine maintenance tasks on building tools following manufacturer's instructions
- ✓ Follow specifications taken from geometric drawings in carrying out building tasks
- ✓ Fulfil specifications taken from scale drawings and calculate measurements of works in carrying out building tasks
- ✓ Comply with specifications listed in a contract of works for a building project
- ✓ Carry out tasks related to the construction of different types of arches from drawings
- ✓ Perform tasks related to the construction of different types of stairs from drawings
- ✓ Comply with the basic principles of construction used in the building industry
- ✓ Responsibly prepare and lay bricks and traditional stone
- ✓ Collaborate with co-workers and supervisors in the preparation and completion of concrete works
- ✓ Carry out tasks to clean the work site and complete the given building project with a professional finish
