On successful completion of the Vocational Education and Training Award in Occupational Health and Safety, the learner will be able to:

- ✓ Carry out tasks in accordance with the principles of Occupational Health and Safety in the workplace
- ✓ Advise on the different characteristics of hazard and risk
- ✓ Identify and communicate hazards
- ✓ Perform tasks related to risk assessments and documentation
- ✓ Undertake tasks to remove or mitigate hazards and minimise risks
- ✓ Conform to current Occupational Health and Safety legislation
- ✓ Create reports and other relevant documentation on Occupational Health and Safety issues
- ✓ Implement and review Occupational Health and Safety best practices to minimise risks
- ✓ Conform to best housekeeping practices
- ✓ Advise on the suitability of various equipment used for the prevention of harm and protection of personnel and property
- ✓ Advise on where best to display suitable equipment for the prevention of harm and protection of personnel and property
- ✓ Comply with an appropriate action response sequence that considers the safety of oneself and other persons when handling an emergency
- ✓ Ensure to appropriately adhere to one's responsibilities, in consideration of the safety of oneself and other persons, in the event of an emergency
- ✓ Carry out emergency response tasks according to suitable processes and procedures
