


SEC Preventive Classes 2022
Guidelines for Students

Dear Students,

We welcome you to the 2022 Free SEC Preventive Classes being held to support you in preparation for the August/September exams. To ensure that this experience will be as enriching and successful as possible we will need you to follow the following guidelines:

1. For your first lesson, you should be present on premises 15 minutes before your lesson starts. You will be expected to find your respective classroom according to your room number. Make sure that you bring this information with you.
2. Students who chose to attend online will still need to attend the first lesson/s in class at the centre as per timetable received so as to collect past papers and meet teacher/s.
3. First sessions are from 8:30am to 10:30 and second sessions are from 11:00 to 13:00. Please be punctual as much as possible. It is very inappropriate to enter in a session when the lesson has already started.
4. You should come prepared for all your lessons. Kindly bring your own pens, foolscaps and past papers provided to you during the first lesson/s.

6. You will only be allowed on premises during the time of your allocated lessons. No loitering will be permitted.



7. Please attend regularly and notify your teachers if you won't be able to come during the following sessions.
8. Mobiles are to be switched off or kept on silent mode not to disrupt the lesson. They cannot be used during the lesson.
9. Eating should not take place inside the building. Please ensure that you keep the premises as clean as possible. You may drink water during lessons.
10. Students who cause any damage to the premises will be asked to cover the costs related to such damage.
11. It is utmost importance that you come for the lessons dressed up decently. May we remind that you will be in an educational set up.
12. You are requested to fill in the Annex form by the end the first week. This has been sent to you via email. Should you find any difficulty, you can ask the centre coordinator for a hard copy. Do not use any correction fluid and please use a blue biro.
