Applying for this course

To apply for this course, you should have completed compulsory schooling. This course is open for persons working within the construction sector or persons with a foreign background and aspiring to work in the construction industry.

TCNs applying for this course need to have a valid residence permit throughout the whole course duration and need to be in employment.

Course Duration

This course is of 30 hours duration and consists of two Modules

- Module 1 is of 14 hours duration
- Module 2 is of 16 hours duration - (including 1-hour assessment)

The delivery of this Course will be mainly held through a series of discussions and hands-on exercises. The trainer will also be holding lessons with the learners which will consist of various presentations.

General assessment policy and procedures for this course:
