Award in Green Jobs Motivational Training

Applying for this course:

This course is ideal for those individuals who wish to learn what Green Jobs are and how they can contribute to the restoration of the environment and to social equity as well as how they can form part of Malta's new economic model.

Individuals who completed compulsory schooling up to 65 years of age and who hold MQF Level 2 Qualification OR have at least one year work experience.

Course Duration

This course is of 25 hours duration and consists of one Module - (including 1-hour assessment)

General pedagogical guidelines and procedures for this course:

The delivery of this course will be mainly held through a series of discussions and hands-on training. These will enable learners to practice and consolidate the classroom training. The trainer will also be holding lessons with the learners which will consist of various presentations, including demonstrations.

General assessment policy and procedures for this course:

The learners shall be assessed through the use of an 'open book' assessment whereby they are provided with 10 short features. Learners shall be asked to read the small features and answer the multiple questions provided based on such features.
