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ACCOUNTING

AWARD IN BUSINESS ACCOUNTING

 90 Tuition hours  Delivered online

 MQF Level 3


This course provides a foundational understanding of accounting within business contexts. Learners will gain practical skills in bookkeeping, ledger accounting, financial reporting, VAT, and bank reconciliation, while aligning with Maltese regulations. Topics include petty cash, trial balances, final accounts for various entities, asset depreciation, and interpretation of financial data through ratios. Learners will also explore both manual and computerised systems, working alongside supervisors to manage accruals, prepayments, and tax control processes.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 2 qualification in both Mathematics and English Language

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AWARD IN ADVANCED BUSINESS ACCOUNTING

 100 Tuition hours  Delivered online

 MQF Level 4

This advanced course builds on core accounting skills to address complex business scenarios. Learners will cover branch and company accounts, cost and management accounting, share and debenture issues, financial group consolidation, and incomplete accounts. Emphasis is placed on budgeting, variance analysis, capital appraisal, ratio analysis, and decision-making techniques. The course aligns with Standard Accounting Practices and IFRS, preparing learners to support supervisory roles and contribute effectively to strategic financial reporting and business control functions.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 3 qualification in Accounts

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AWARD IN PAYROLL PROCESSING

 41 Tuition hours  Delivered online

 MQF Level 3

This course equips learners with the skills to accurately manage payroll processes in line with Maltese legislation. Topics include employee data management, payroll calculations for full- and part-time staff, national insurance contributions, fringe benefits, and final settlement tax (FSS) documentation. Learners will also handle payslips, FS forms, termination payments, and statutory reports, both manually and electronically. Emphasis is placed on compliance, accuracy, and using payroll software to support organisational payroll and reporting functions.

Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 2 qualification in both Mathematics and English Language

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AGRICULTURAL SCIENCE

INTRODUCTION TO AGRICULTURE, PRACTICES, TECHNOLOGY AND POLICY

 12 Tuition hours

 Classroom-based training

 MQF Level 3


This course explores the history of agriculture, modern technologies, and sustainable practices. Students will learn to improve farming efficiency, soil health, and water conservation. Topics include GMOs, agricultural policies, economic and environmental impacts, farm management, food safety, and the role of technology in farming.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 1 School Leaving Certificate
- Must hold a MQF Level 2 qualification in Award in Principles of Gardening and Landscaping or similar, including the Certificate of Competence for Gardener and Horticulturalist

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SOIL AND PLANT SCIENCE

 21 Tuition hours  Classroom-based training

 MQF Level 3


This course focuses on managing soil health for optimal plant growth and sustainability. Students will learn to utilise organic fertilisers and mitigate the environmental impacts of fertiliser use. The syllabus includes different types of inorganic fertilisers, their nutrient availability, and interactions with soil properties. Learners will also explore the role of organic matter in soil structure and nutrient retention, ensuring effective use of both organic and inorganic fertilisers.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 1 School Leaving Certificate
- Must hold a MQF Level 2 qualification in Award in Principles of Gardening and Landscaping or similar, including the Certificate of Competence for Gardener and Horticulturalist



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GENETIC TECHNIQUES AND INNOVATION

 12 Tuition hours  Classroom-based training

 MQF Level 3


This module evaluates the benefits and controversies of GMOs in agriculture, including increased crop yield, pest resistance, and nutritional enhancement. Students will understand the techniques behind GMO development and their role in modern agriculture. The curriculum covers ethical, environmental, and health concerns, as well as the integration of aquaponics and other innovations. Learners will also compare traditional and modern agricultural practices, assessing their evolution and relevance in today's farming systems.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 1 School Leaving Certificate
- Must hold a MQF Level 2 qualification in Award in Principles of Gardening and Landscaping or similar, including the Certificate of Competence for Gardener and Horticulturalist



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SUSTAINABLE AND INTENSIVE AGRICULTURE

 12 Tuition hours  Classroom-based training

 MQF Level 3


This course addresses sustainable farming practices and their role in global food security. Students will explore food safety standards, certification processes, and the impacts of intensive agriculture. This module also compares organic, biological, and conventional farming methods, emphasising soil health, water conservation, and biodiversity. Learners will implement strategies to enhance farm sustainability, optimising resource use and improving environmental outcomes.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 1 School Leaving Certificate
- Must hold a MQF Level 2 qualification in Award in Principles of Gardening and Landscaping or similar, including the Certificate of Competence for Gardener and Horticulturalist

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PESTS, DISEASES AND IPM


 12 Tuition hours  Classroom-based training


 MQF Level 3


This course covers methods for preventing and controlling pests and diseases in crops and livestock. Students will learn to use pesticides safely, recognise key pests and diseases, and differentiate between various types. The course content includes developing prevention plans, following best practices for pesticide storage and disposal, and complying with regulatory and safety standards. Learners will also implement protective measures for human health and the environment and conduct pest and disease assessments in agricultural settings.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 1 School Leaving Certificate
- Must hold a MQF Level 2 qualification in Award in Principles of Gardening and Landscaping or similar, including the Certificate of Competence for Gardener and Horticulturalist

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ANIMAL HUSBANDRY

 21 Tuition hours  Classroom-based training

 MQF Level 3


This course focuses on sustainable and humane animal farming practices. Students will learn ethical handling, housing, and management of livestock, ensuring welfare standards. The curriculum covers health and welfare management across various livestock industries, preventive health care measures, and principles of animal breeding. Learners will also advise on nutritional needs, monitor animal behaviour, and identify signs of stress or poor health.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 1 School Leaving Certificate
- Must hold a MQF Level 2 qualification in Award in Principles of Gardening and Landscaping or similar, including the Certificate of Competence for Gardener and Horticulturalist

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FARM MANAGEMENT

 21 Tuition hours  Classroom-based training

 MQF Level 3


This course focuses on developing and implementing effective farm plans and budgets based on comprehensive business management principles. Students will produce decision-making tools, execute risk management plans, and ensure compliance with agricultural laws and regulations. The training also covers fundamental principles of farm business management, assessing economic and operational factors, and developing sustainable resource management practices to enhance long-term productivity.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 1 School Leaving Certificate
- Must hold a MQF Level 2 qualification in Award in Principles of Gardening and Landscaping or similar, including the Certificate of Competence for Gardener and Horticulturalist



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THE USE OF MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT

 21 Tuition hours  Classroom-based training

 MQF Level 3


This module focuses on maintaining and repairing agricultural machinery. Students will develop maintenance schedules, diagnose and perform basic repairs, and comply with safety protocols. The curriculum explores components and operating principles of farm equipment, comparing traditional and modern machinery. Additionally, learners will explore recent innovations, including automation and precision agriculture, and implement sustainable practices to reduce emissions. Eco-friendly alternatives, such as renewable energy-powered equipment, are also examined.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 1 School Leaving Certificate
- Must hold a MQF Level 2 qualification in Award in Principles of Gardening and Landscaping or similar, including the Certificate of Competence for Gardener and Horticulturalist

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FOOD AND FOOD SYSTEMS

 12 Tuition hours  Classroom-based training

 MQF Level 3


This course focuses on monitoring and improving the sustainability of food systems. Students will ensure the quality and compliance of processed foods through proper techniques and certification standards. During this training, the production and benefits of fermented products, key components of food systems, and strategies to enhance sustainability from environmental, economic, and social perspectives will also be explored. Lastly, learners will develop and propose improvements for sustainable food systems.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 1 School Leaving Certificate
- Must hold a MQF Level 2 qualification in Award in Principles of Gardening and Landscaping or similar, including the Certificate of Competence for Gardener and Horticulturalist

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FINAL PROJECT

 12 Tuition hours

 Classroom-based training

 MQF Level 3


In this module, students will conduct a thorough desktop study on a chosen subject area, demonstrating their ability to manage and execute research projects. They will also address the main themes and methodologies covered throughout the programme. At the end of the module, participants will be able to effectively structure, document, and present their research findings in a clear and professional manner.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 1 School Leaving Certificate
- Must hold a MQF Level 2 qualification in Award in Principles of Gardening and Landscaping or similar, including the Certificate of Competence for Gardener and Horticulturalist
- Must have successfully completed all modules under the Agricultural Science category

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BUSINESS SKILLS

AWARD IN EFFECTIVE TEAM WORKING SKILLS

 20 Tuition hours  Delivered online

 MQF Level 4

This course enhances team leadership and collaboration skills. It covers efficient team leadership, team synergy management, conflict resolution strategies, and handling difficult team members. Students will learn to define team roles, be effective team members, and use appropriate communication methods. Ideal for those seeking to improve their team management and leadership skills.

Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 2 qualification or have at least 3 years' work experience

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AWARD IN COMMUNICATION SKILLS

 20 Tuition hours  Delivered online

 MQF Level 4

This course enhances communication skills in diverse contexts. It covers effective use of communication modes, active listening, report-writing, handling challenging situations, and understanding networking personality types. Students will learn appropriate communication techniques, language choice in written communication, and meeting preparation. Ideal for those seeking to improve their professional communication skills.

Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 2 qualification or have at least 3 years' work experience

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AWARD IN ENGLISH FOR BUSINESS

 100 Tuition hours  Delivered online

 MQF Level 4

This course enhances professional communication and presentation skills. It covers making contact with visitors, handling requests, telephone etiquette, business correspondence, setting up meetings, and preparing for presentations. Students will learn to deal with challenging situations, represent the company at trade fairs, and present new ideas. Ideal for those seeking to improve their professional communication skills.

Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 2 qualification in English Language or have at least 3 years' work experience

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AWARD IN WORK ETHICS

 16 Tuition hours  Delivered online

 MQF Level 4

This comprehensive course equips professionals with the knowledge and skills to cultivate an ethical and respectful workplace. Participants will explore core principles of work ethics, strategies for navigating social and cross-cultural diversity, and methods for identifying and addressing conflicts of interest. The course emphasises developing personal integrity, adhering to ethical policies and regulations, and maintaining high-quality standards. Learners will also gain practical skills in managing challenging situations, communicating effectively in multicultural environments, and promoting a positive, compliant, and productive work environment.

Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 2 qualification or have at least 3 years' work experience

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PRINCIPLES OF GDPR

 10 Tuition hours  Delivered online

This course provides an understanding of GDPR, its importance, and key data protection concepts. It delves into the principles of personal data processing, lawfulness, fairness, and transparency. Participants will learn about lawful grounds for processing, conditions for valid consent, and the rights of data subjects, including the right to access and erase data.

Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age

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AWARD IN GDPR FOR THE DATA PROTECTION OFFICER

 20 Tuition hours  Delivered online

 MQF Level 4

This comprehensive GDPR training course equips participants with the knowledge to comply with regulations, plan for compliance, understand legal requirements, identify rights and consents,

handle data breaches, and protect personally identifiable information. It also covers the roles of data controllers and processors, and the implications of non-compliance.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 2 qualification or have at least 3 years' work experience

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PRESENTATION AND PUBLIC SPEAKING SKILLS

 30 Tuition hours

 Blended learning


This course enhances communication skills by exploring theories and models of communication, verbal and non-verbal cues, and effective speech and presentation techniques. It emphasises audience engagement, handling challenging situations, decision-making, leadership skills, and overcoming anxiety. It also covers the use of visual aids, practice and rehearsal strategies, and adapting to different delivery contexts, including online presentations.

Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Should be familiar with computer and mobile phone operation

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CRITICAL THINKING


 10 Tuition hours

 Delivered online

This course on critical thinking explores key concepts like logic, argument analysis, and rhetoric. It emphasises personal development, democratic participation, and wisdom pursuit. It helps identify obstacles to critical thinking, employ problem-solving techniques, and understand components like problem-solving, creativity, and decision-making. It also covers argument construction, persuasion, and ethical solution design.

Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Should be able to communicate and understand English effectively

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ENHANCING CREATIVITY AND INNOVATION

 12 Tuition hours  Delivered online


This course delves into creativity and innovation, their interplay, and their role in problem-solving. It explores the 6 thinking hats of creativity, techniques like STACK and STEPLE, and tools like SWOT and PESTEL analysis. It also covers motivation, imagination, breaking through patterns, managing risks, and selecting solutions using the Impact-Ability Matrix.

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age

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AWARD IN PLANNING AND ORGANISATIONAL SKILLS

 22 Tuition hours  Delivered online

 MQF Level 4


This course focuses on effective planning and time management, enabling participants to create personal systems for managing time, multitasking, and collaborating within a team. It covers process mapping, information management, workspace organisation, decision-making, critical and lateral thinking skills. It also emphasises delegation, leadership, and the preparation of clear schedules with specific milestones and deadlines.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 2 qualification or have at least 3 years' work experience

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CHANGE MANAGEMENT

 16 Tuition hours  Delivered online


This course focuses on emotional intelligence and change management, addressing key concepts, types of changes in organisations, and planning for change. It emphasises dealing with conflict, risk management, and the 5Cs of change management. It also covers communication skills, stress management, team-building strategies, and leadership skills required in change management.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Should be able to communicate and understand English effectively

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AWARD IN INTERPERSONAL SKILLS

 22 Tuition hours

 Delivered online

 MQF Level 4


This course focuses on personal development and interpersonal skills. It covers effective time management, conflict resolution, stress and anger management, dealing with criticism, and handling difficult relationships. It also emphasises self-confidence, emotional intelligence, creativity, innovation, effective communication, flexibility, adaptability, self-management, multitasking, and leadership skills.

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 2 qualification or have at least 3 years' work experience

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EMOTIONAL INTELLIGENCE

 10 Tuition hours

 Delivered online


This course is a comprehensive guide to Emotional Intelligence. It equips learners with the understanding of the concept and its five key elements: self-awareness, self-regulation, motivation, empathy, and social skills. Through practical techniques, learners will enhance self-awareness, self-regulation, and improve motivation, empathy, and social skills. The course also explores the benefits of Emotional Intelligence and how to effectively manage emotions in various situations.

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age

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CONFLICT RESOLUTION

 10 Tuition hours  Delivered online

This course offers learners a detailed understanding of key conflict concepts, including types, sources, stages, and strategies for prevention, management, and resolution. It delves into the theory of the Four Cs and assists learners in identifying conflict sources. Additionally, this training provides action plans for moving forward from conflict and teaches skills such as active listening, empathy, compromise, and effective communication. Lastly, this course emphasises the importance of prevention plans to reduce future conflicts.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Should be able to communicate and understand English effectively

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AWARD IN INDIVIDUAL LEADERSHIP SKILLS

 14 Tuition hours  Delivered online

 MQF Level 4

This dynamic course empowers professionals to cultivate essential leadership skills and drive personal growth. Participants explore their strengths, address development areas, and master techniques for self-confidence, resilience, and stress management. You'll analyse leadership styles, learn effective communication, active listening, and trust-building, and master persuasion for personal and professional success. The course culminates in self-evaluation and character development, equipping you to lead with authenticity.

Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Should be able to communicate and understand English effectively

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CARE WORKERS

AWARD IN HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE

 284 Tuition hours  Delivered online and includes a 150-hour placement


 MQF Level 3


This course prepares aspiring Health Carers with essential skills in client care, hygiene, communication, and teamwork. It covers practical training, clinical observation techniques, infection control, and personal mental health. Emphasising respect for cultural diversity, dignity, and independence, the course equips participants to handle care-related situations and communicate effectively within multidisciplinary healthcare teams.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 2 qualification in Maltese Language and/or English Language
- Maltese citizens must provide a clean Police Conduct Certificate that is not older than 1 year. Non-Maltese citizens must provide a Police Conduct or proof of good standing from their home country, translated into Maltese or English (if not already employed)

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AWARD IN MOVING AND SAFE HANDLING FOR CARE WORKERS


 6 Tuition hours  Classroom-based training


 MQF Level 3

This course equips participants with the knowledge and practical skills to safely move and handle patients. It emphasizes risk assessment, proper techniques tailored to various scenarios, and the use of assistive devices. Learners will explore relevant anatomy, body mechanics, and injury prevention strategies to ensure the safety and well-being of both patients and caregivers.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 3 qualification in Health and Social Care or equivalent

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AWARD FOR HEALTH CARE WORKERS

 105 Tuition hours  Delivered online


 MQF Level 4


This course prepares learners to provide compassionate, ethical, and person-centred care. It focuses on accurate record-keeping, safeguarding, infection prevention, and effective communication with clients and stakeholders. Learners will uphold dignity, confidentiality, and inclusivity while managing challenging behaviours and promoting client independence. The course also covers collaboration with multidisciplinary teams and adherence to legal and professional standards to ensure high-quality, respectful care.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Should be an existing Health Carer and hold a MQF Level 3 qualification in Health Care
- Possess a MQF Level 3 qualification in Health and Social Care or equivalent
 - Note: Prospective learners who have completed the Jobsplus' course Award in Health and Social Care at MQF Level 3 may be exempted from following Modules 6 and 7
- Maltese citizens must provide a clean Police Conduct Certificate that is not older than 1 year. Non-Maltese citizens must provide a Police Conduct or proof of good standing from their home country, translated into Maltese or English (if not already employed)

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AWARD IN DEMENTIA CARE AND AWARENESS


 9 Tuition hours  Delivered online

 MQF Level 3


This course prepares learners to deliver person-centred care for individuals living with dementia. It covers the types, symptoms, and stages of dementia, along with risk factors and prevention. Learners will develop skills in communication, behaviour management, cognitive stimulation, and environmental adaptation. The course also addresses end-of-life care, family support, and caregiver well-being, promoting empathy, dignity, and inclusion in dementia care settings.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 3 qualification in Health and Social Care or equivalent

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AWARD IN NUTRITION AND FOOD SAFETY

 9 Tuition hours  Delivered online


 MQF Level 3


This course provides learners with the knowledge and skills to manage nutrition and food safety within healthcare environments. It explores macronutrients, micronutrients, dietary needs across life stages, and therapeutic diets. Learners will gain insight into food hygiene, labelling, storage, and the prevention of foodborne illnesses. The course also addresses nutritional management for chronic conditions, malnutrition, and compliance with health and safety standards to support patient well-being.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 3 qualification in Health and Social Care or equivalent

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MALTESE CULTURE FOR HEALTH CARERS

 7 Tuition hours  Delivered online

This course explores Maltese traditions, family dynamics, and religious influences on caregiving. Participants will learn to identify attitudes towards ageing/disability, develop culturally sensitive communication, and adapt care approaches. Strategies for navigating cultural differences and ensuring respectful, inclusive care for diverse clients will be emphasised.

Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age

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SAFEGUARDING THE WELL-BEING OF VULNERABLE INDIVIDUALS

 7 Tuition hours  Delivered online

This course defines and explains elder and disability abuse, covering its forms and warning signs across care settings. Participants will analyse risk factors, learn correct reporting procedures, and apply inclusive intervention strategies. The course also focuses on developing preventive measures, fostering effective communication to build trust, and evaluating real-life case studies through interactive role-playing.

Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age

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CHILDCARE EDUCATORS

VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING AWARD FOR CHILDCARE EDUCATORS

 870 Tuition hours   Delivered online and includes a 500-hour placement

 MQF Level 4

This course delivers a thorough foundation in early childhood care, development, and safety. It covers child development theories, inclusive practices, communication, and planning of age-appropriate activities. Learners will gain skills in safeguarding, observation, documentation, and supporting children with additional needs. The course also includes essential training in health and hygiene, nutrition, and first aid - covering emergency response, CPR, and accident management - ensuring learners can provide safe, responsive, and high-quality care in line with national regulations and best practice.

Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 2 qualification in Mathematics, English and Maltese, or a qualification related to Health Care
 - Note: Non-Maltese citizens are exempt from the Maltese language qualification but must demonstrate the ability to communicate in Maltese

- Maltese citizens must provide a clean Police Conduct Certificate that is not older than 1 year
- Non-Maltese citizens must provide a Police Conduct or proof of good standing from their home country, translated into Maltese or English (if not already employed)
- Individuals who completed the VET Award in Childcare (0-3 years) from 2017 onwards, or the VET Award in Childcare (0-5 years) from 2014 (both offered by Jobsplus), can follow the new modules (Modules 8, 9, 11, and 12) only

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STORYTELLING IN EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

 12 Tuition hours

 Delivered online

This course explores the power of storytelling as a tool for learning and development in early childhood. Learners will practise a variety of storytelling techniques, including the use of props, puppets, and voice modulation. The course emphasises adapting stories to children's interests and cultural backgrounds, while fostering language development, emotional intelligence, and social interaction through engaging, participatory storytelling experiences.

Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age


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IMPLEMENTING THE CHILD-LED APPROACH IN EARLY YEARS EDUCATION

 8 Tuition hours


 Delivered online


This course defines the child-led approach and its principles, exploring how pedagogical models support it. Participants will apply observation and planning strategies to guide learning based on children's interests, facilitating environments that promote autonomy. The course also covers critical reflection on practice aligned with Malta's quality standards and ECEC framework, and collaboration with families.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- This course is ideal for anyone currently working in childcare or as an early years educator, as well as those aspiring to enter these fields



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KEYWORD SIGNING FOR EARLY YEARS

 9 Tuition hours  Delivered online



This course defines keyword signing and its importance, differentiating it from full sign language. This training covers the latest technologies in organic farming, recycling processes, and the use of biogas plants for waste-to-energy conversion. It also includes equipment maintenance, marketing strategies for produce, and financial management for sustainability. The course provides



information on available schemes and funds, the benefits of organic farming for businesses, and the importance of good record-keeping practices.

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CHALLENGES TO ORGANIC FARMERS AND MITIGATIONS

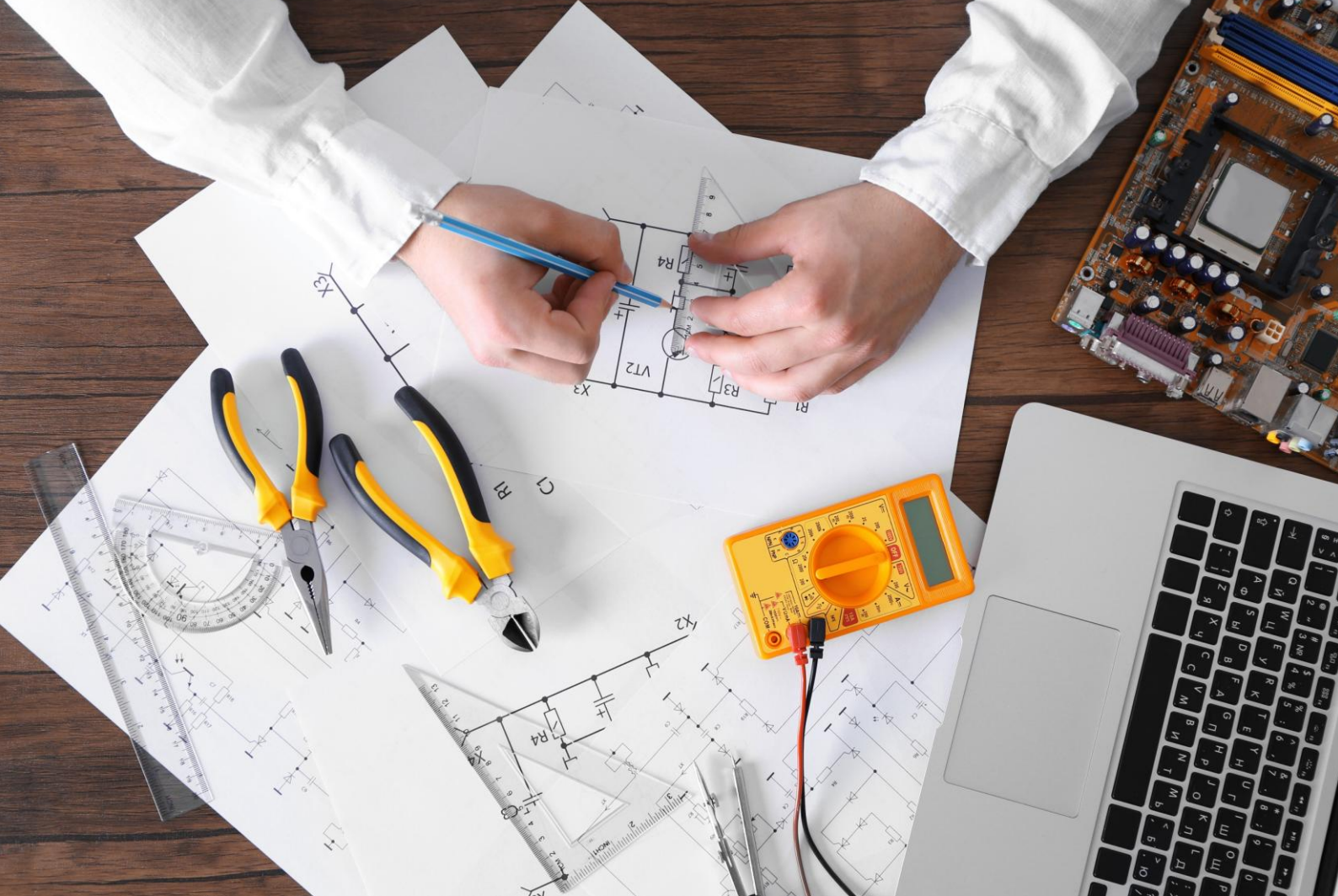
 10 Tuition hours  Classroom-based training

This training addresses the challenges faced by organic farmers, such as water availability, field location, cost of produce, and societal awareness. It proposes sustainable solutions like cover cropping and seed saving. The course also explores the creation of a circular economy in agriculture, the virtuous cycle between farmers and consumers, and provides various case studies for better understanding.

Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Should be able to communicate and understand English or Maltese effectively


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TECHNICAL

AWARD IN PRINCIPLES OF ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONICS ENGINEERING


 180 Tuition hours  Classroom-based training


 MQF Level 3


This course provides comprehensive training in electronics/electrical trade safety, hazard management, and use of protective gear. It includes handling hazardous materials, RoHS compliance, and manual operations. It also covers mathematical operations, energy principles, circuit calculations, and electronic component handling. The course emphasises the correct use of testing instruments, assembly processes, and soldering techniques, concluding with fibre optic cable handling.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 2 qualification in English Language and either Mathematics or Physics

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AWARD IN REFRIGERATION AND AIR-CONDITIONING


 95 Tuition hours  Classroom-based training


 MQF Level 3


This training covers the maintenance and handling of tools and equipment in line with health and safety regulations, including the proper handling of hazardous materials. It delves into the components of a Refrigeration and Air-Conditioning (RAC) system, its installation, repair, and maintenance. The course also discusses climate change, the Kyoto Protocol, and the use and management of refrigerants, including compliance with relevant legislation.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 1 qualification in Mathematics, English and Maltese



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AWARD FOR ASSISTANT ELECTRICAL FITTER (ELECTRICIAN)


 101 Tuition hours  Classroom-based training


 MQF Level 2


This course imparts essential electrical safety, circuit creation, and equipment installation skills. It emphasises collaboration with licensed professionals, adherence to regulations, and correct use of protective devices. It covers installation requirements, maintenance procedures, and fault repair in various electrical contexts.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 1 qualification in English and Mathematics

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ELECTRICAL DOMESTIC INSTALLATIONS (LICENCE A)





 110 Tuition hours  Classroom-based training

This training covers a wide range of topics in electrical domestic installation, including electrical units, resistance networks, Ohm's law, voltage drop, power loss, and illumination. It delves into the IEE regulations, safety requirements, control sequences, load assessment, circuit types, protection

needs, and electromagnetic induction. The course also includes practical aspects like installation testing, earthing, wiring systems, and cable selection.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess an 'O' Level qualification in Mathematics and Physics.
 - Individuals who do not possess these requirements will be requested to follow a short course and obtain a pass mark in basic mathematics and basic physics to be eligible
- Able to provide a medical certificate confirming no colour blindness (required for safety reasons)

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AWARD IN PHYSICS & MATHEMATICS FOR ELECTRICAL FITTERS





 100 Tuition hours  Classroom-based training

 MQF Level 2

This comprehensive training covers a broad spectrum of physics, mathematics, and electrical principles. It includes arithmetic operations, algebra, geometry, trigonometry, thermodynamics, kinetic and potential energy, electrical calculations, principles of electricity, properties of conductors and insulators, principles of magnetism, differences between DC and AC, and calculations of RMS and average values. Practical applications and problem-solving are emphasised throughout the course.

Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Possess a MQF Level 1 qualification in Mathematics, English or Maltese Language.
 - Individuals who do not possess these requirements will be requested to complete a Jobsplus-approved pre-assessment test to determine the learner's level of competence and a pass (45%) is required to be eligible

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TRADES

AWARD IN PRINCIPLES OF GARDENING AND LANDSCAPING

 144 Tuition hours



Classroom-based training

 MQF Level 2


This course provides a comprehensive understanding of gardening and landscaping principles. It covers soil management, composting, fertilization, plant selection and maintenance, pest and disease control, irrigation, tree and shrub care, and landscape design. It also emphasises safety measures, customer satisfaction, and environmental regulations.

Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- While not strictly mandatory, a MQF Level 1 qualification in Mathematics, English and Maltese Language is highly recommended to support your learning throughout the course.


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AWARD IN CARPENTRY AND JOINERY

 157 Tuition hours

 Classroom-based training


 MQF Level 2


This course delves into the fundamentals of carpentry and joinery, focusing on safety protocols, effective use of tools, timber classification, joinery techniques, machine operation, assembly of fitments, and troubleshooting. It also highlights the importance of environmental compliance, energy efficiency, and clear communication.


Entry requirements

- Must have completed compulsory schooling and be up to 65 years of age
- Should be able to communicate and understand English or Maltese effectively

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
